Net profits 50% to boosters, 50% to basketball equally divided between girls and boys.

Regarding leftover non-perishable bb food left over from tournament - Rose Perez says the school owns the non-perishables from the tournament and is to be used for basketball snack bar per Sue Lunsford. Rose says it is possibly about \$200-300 worth of food (nacho cheese, chips, chili, condiments, paper goods, etc.). She has copies of the receipts, as does the school.
